The Epsilon Rho Lambda Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity created this scholarship in memory of George L. Butler, DDS to make a college education accessible to a deserving student.

1. This scholarship is available to students who are:
 - African American male
 - A graduating high school senior from the Cumberland County or Fort Bragg area and has been accepted to a four-year accredited college or university
 - Demonstrated financial need through Student Aid Report (SAR).
 - Not family members of the Selection Committee.
2. Applications should be typed or legibly printed in ink.
3. Submit **one original application**
4. **One official transcript** is required.
5. **Three different letters of recommendation** including from a teacher and guidance counselor in support of your application should be forwarded by the person writing the letter to Cumberland Community Foundation. Use the reference form included with this application unless otherwise indicated. You may also enclose letters of recommendation in sealed, tamper evident envelopes with your application and supporting materials.
6. Financial need is a criterion, so you must submit a copy of your **Student Aid Report (SAR)** compiled from your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) (www.fafsa.ed.gov) **and your financial award letter** if available.
7. Submit your response to **scholarship essay question** on a separate sheet of plain white paper. Include the name of the scholarship you are applying for on the top right of each page. Your responses must be typed. **Write a two page essay on: Why are you seeking higher education and what are your plans after you receive your degree?**
8. Semi-finalists for scholarship will be asked to have a personal interview with members of the Scholarship Selection Committee. The Committee will contact the applicant with the date and location.
9. Do not staple your application materials. Please use paperclips only.
10. By the **deadline of April 4, 2008**, send completed application, transcripts, SAR, financial award letter and additional materials required to:
